

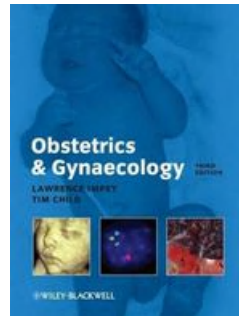

This book is ideal for all medical students as it deals with all the presenting complaints, gives differentials/possible causes and then gives a precise description of the investigations and management. Majority of students prefer this book for its layout and 'easy to read' chapters. I found the information to be very concise and the 'at a glance' boxes summarised the content precisely. Furthermore, this book is very well illustrated the management section at the back is very useful for revision. Many postgraduates I have spoken to still refer to this book and recommend it for anyone wanting to build a basic core understanding.
